




VBS

Generosity

Ministry Fund

Our general, or operating fund, supports our regular expenses related to doing ministry together. This includes things like our lights and heat, music licenses and communion supplies, paper and management software, and wages for staff. These funds are separate from any designated funds.

As of the end of May, our undesignated offering was \$60,307.12 of the budgeted \$78,080 for the same time frame.

Roof Fund

Our goal has been to raise \$100k to meet the estimated cost of replacing the sanctuary roof.

As of the end of May our roof fund is at \$94,051.97 and council is confident we can move forward with the project.

In recent weeks, workers have been doing final diagnostics before beginning the work of replacement. We look forward to blessing a new roof soon!
